**RE: BOIL WATER ADVISORY RESCINDED FOR THE BENITO PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM**

Drinking Water Officer, Yousuf Khan, has advised me that the Benito public water system has met all conditions for rescinding the boil water advisory and that bacteriological testing results meet regulatory standards.

I am therefore rescinding the boil water advisory that was placed for the Benito distribution system [**2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**] on **February 3, 2025**.

Please ensure all water users are notified that the advisory has been rescinded, and that normal water usage can be resumed. A copy of this letter can be provided as notification. Notices posted in public locations are to be removed.
